Brief Description	Mickey Buckins & The New Breed (not the similarly named Cortez Greer group), was a short-lived (1965-'67) but important Alabama-based soul group. Besides recording the great soul gem SILLY GIRL, Buckins became a significant songwriter and session musician, working with the likes of Bob Dylan, Dionne Warwick, Clarence Carter, Larry Gatlin, Mac Davis, Millie Jackson, Levon Helm, and The Oakridge Boys.
