According to Steve Allen, the band's drummer from 1965 through 1968, Roy Smith, the composer of "Gettin' Fired Up" got so excited ( fired up) when the band was recording the song that he ran out of the studio and started banging on the piano. Another Pallbearer song, "Music With Soul", became a staple in the '70s at one of the best All Nighters night club called Wigan Casino. This was during the heyday of the Northern Soul Scene.
