Brief Description	Members of the Augusta based R&B band became members of both Georgia Prophets and Georgia Best. After the original Georgia Prophets began to go in different directions, the turnover in the various Augusta bands seemed to increase. However, Roy Smith always seemed to be in the middle of Augusta's R&B movement, whether writing, producing or performing. Sample 'Let's Go To That Loving Place", (Disk # 14) one of Roy's productions with The Soul Seekers from 1965. This guy should have been a major U. S. recording star. The Soul Seekers ultimately evolved into Georgia's Best featuring Billy Walker.
